

PRIVACY POLICY

This privacy policy applies to the Stanwick Village Hall, charity number 1122786 and to the website at www.stanwickvillagehall.org. It explains what personal information we collect about you and how we use it.

We collect your personal information when you make direct enquiries with us, on completion of our hire agreement for hall rooms, by visiting our website or by registering for our Village Hall Newsletter.

How we use your information

This privacy notice tells you what to expect when we collect personal information. We will make it clear when we collect personal information and will explain what we intend to do with it. We do not share your personal information with third parties unless we have your consent or to comply with a legal obligation.

Contact with the Village Hall

When you contact the Village Hall we will obtain sufficient information to enable us to contact you. If you enter into a hire agreement with the Village Hall we will obtain sufficient information to enable us to identify you and your guests and to invoice you for the costs involved. If you opt to register to receive the Village Hall Newsletter we will obtain sufficient information to send you, by email or post, your copy of the newsletter and record whether you chose the HTML format preference.

Visitors to the website

When someone visits the Stanwick Village Hall website (www.stanwickvillagehall.org), we collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to various parts of the site. We collect this information in a way that does not identify users personally. If for any reason we do decide to collect more information on individual users, we will notify users prior to this occurring.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that are placed on your computer by websites that you visit. They are widely used in order to make websites work more efficiently. They also provide statistical information to the owners of the site.

Use of cookies by the web host provider

We use UK2.NET and Tapiochre Ltd to host and maintain our website. They may use cookies that are essential in order to enable you to move around the website and use its features reliably. These may include cookies to:

- Persist the login of a user during a session at a given site.
- Automatically log a user in, if they have previously click "Remember me" when logging in

Use of cookies by Stanwick Village Hall

These cookies collect information about how visitors use a website, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies do not collect information that identifies a visitor. All information these cookies collect is aggregated and therefore anonymous. It is only used to improve how a website works.

The information the cookies collect is used to improve how the website works. By using this website you agree that we can place these types of cookies on your device:

Cookie Name	Expires After	Purpose
_utma	2 years from set/update	Used to distinguish users and sessions. The cookie is created when no existing utma cookies exists. The cookie is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.
_utmb	30 mins from set/update	Used to determine new sessions/visits. The cookie is created when no existing utmb cookies exists. The cookie is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.
_utmc	End of browser session	Set for interoperability with Google's legacy urchin.js. Historically, this cookie operated in conjunction with the utmb cookie to determine whether the user was in a new session/visit.
_utmz	6 months from set/update	Stores the traffic source or campaign that explains how the user reached your site. The cookie is created when the javascript library executes and is updated every time data is sent to Google Analytics.
Acceptance cookies	30 days	When a visitor accepts cookies from the website, the ccm_cookies_accepted cookie is added to the user's device with a value of "Yes".
Session cookies	30 days	These cookies are used when a user visits the site, they aid navigation around the site.
